FISHING DAYS

Day 1:

All vessels to gather 1 Nautical Mile outside of launching harbour at 6:00am for BLESSING OF THE FLEET and official GUN start of the 2022 CARRY CAT OFFSHORE CLASSIC.

Lines up at 16:00

Weighing starts at 16:00 pm and ends at 19:00 pm

Day 2/3/4:

Launch starts at 5:00 am and lines up at 16:00 pm

Weighing from 16:00pm to 19:00 pm

1 Dinner will be provided during the course of the week – to be determined

Final day

Launch starts at 5:00 am and weighing/scales closes at 16:00 pm.

Should the final fishing day be before the 7th of May the scale will close as per normal times, weather permitting.

BOAT AUCTION OFFSHORE CLASSIC 2022

1. The owner of the boat will have first option to buy his boat to a max of R 10 000. If he doesn't purchase, the auction will start and up to a max of R10 000.
2. An Amount to the value of 5% of the total value of the auction will go towards the Junior Development of GBBAC
3. An additional 10% of the remaining total amount will go towards the boat that caught the biggest fish, IF not purchased by owner.
4. The remaining 85% will go towards the highest bidder of the winning boat.
